## **Native Title Anthropologist Grants Program**

### **INFORMATION SHEET: 2011–12 funding round**

This Information Sheet provides information for applicants seeking funding under the 2011–12 funding round (round two) for the Native Title Anthropologist Grants Program. Please read in conjunction with the Program Guidelines.

- A maximum amount of \$526,000 is available for grants in this funding round. It is anticipated that funded projects will commence on or as close to 1 July 2011 as possible.
- Funding is not recurrent. Funds will only be provided for a single year. Any subsequent funding would depend on the organisation being successful in round three.
- As the panel will consider value for money, applications are more likely to be competitive if they:
  - achieve broad outcomes across the priority areas of need
  - benefit as much of the system as possible, for example, a range of States and Territories
  - meet more than one of the identified priority areas.
- Each application should be able to be considered individually on its merits and not be reliant on the success of other applications or a later funding round.
- Although there is a notional cap of \$150,000 per application, an application may be approved above this amount if the funding is considered reasonable and represents value for money.
- Funding will *not* be provided for projects that duplicate existing programs, already receive significant funding or seek retrospective funding.
- Collaboration between organisations is encouraged if more priority areas could be met and more anthropologists in the system would benefit. However, one organisation must be listed as the primary applicant.
